

Our Safe Routes to School Coordinator - Jamie Carlton, is busy at work planning fun and educational events for our walkers/bikers. In addition to our Safe Routes to School, the City of Kimberly has been awarded a pilot program through Idaho Smart Growth, which will be working to compile a “complete streets” inventory, including current sidewalks and their conditions. This information will be utilized by the City for our future planning and implementation of additional sidewalk projects throughout the City.

Another very exciting piece of information I wanted to share is concerning the light at Red Cap Corner. The Kimberly Police Department has received complaints from pedestrians about vehicles parking on the sidewalks in the residential neighborhoods. Parking with the wheels of a vehicle on the sidewalk is in violation of Idaho Code 49-660. The fine for violating this code is \$46.50. The Kimberly Police Department has been issuing written warning notices since September 19th. Beginning October 1st the Police department will begin issuing citation for these violations. Resolution No. 267 was passed August 25th 2011.

Whereas, the City is proposing a rate increase for the City's Water, Sewer, Sanitation fees, and a fee for the maintenance repair of the Pressurized Irrigation systems;

The following monthly residential utility charges shall be as follows:

Sewer:	\$37.36
Sanitation:	\$ 8.95
Water:	\$ 2.00 per 1,000 gallons
Bond: 1994 Bond	\$ 6.58
Bond: 2009 Bond	\$16.84

Each resident with a pressurized irrigation system shall be charged each month a fee for the maintenance and repair of the pressurized irrigation systems based on the following formula:

One half of the residential lot square footage multiplied by \$0.00168336.

If the weather turns unfavorable and you need to put your project on hold, please give me a call or send an email to let me know so that the permit does not expire due to lack of activity. International Building Code Section 105.5 states that every permit issued shall become invalid if work authorized on site by such permit is suspended or abandoned for a period of 180 days after the time the work is commenced, but extensions are available if specifically requested. I've seen some beautiful projects while performing building inspections this summer, what a talented city! JRN
