concluding with the Council Meeting to follow at 6:00pm.


After nearly two years of temporary quarters, Kimberly City Hall has a new home!

The Old City Hall building was one of the original buildings in Kimberly circuit 1900. Though the Old Hall had served the public for decades, its deteriorating condition forced the City Hall Offices to move out due to safety reasons. Since the middle of 2010 the City Clerk's offices, City Administrator's office, Mayor's office, Public Works Director's office and P&Z Department have all shared a 1800 sq/ft space in the City Library Building. Now we have completed the purchase and remodel of our New City Hall at 242 Hwy 30 E.. The new building will house not only the above mentioned offices but also the Police Department, CSO office, workspaces and the City Council Chambers. All of the City Staff are extremely excited to have a facility that provide a central location for the city government and help to provide even better service to all the citizens of Kimberly.
