## Accepted Co-Mingled Recyclable Materials

- Newspapers: including inserts, magazines, and catalogs.
- Aluminum and Steel (Tin): cans (rinse empty cans - labels are okay - aerosol cans must be empty - pesticide cans are prohibited), pie tins (rinsed), wire hangers (stripped of foam and paper).
- Mixed Paper: junk mail, white or pastel ledger, cereal and frozen food boxes, paper bags, envelopes, fax paper, computer paper, brochures, greeting cards, phone books, construction paper, paper towel cores, copy paper, note paper, index cards, writing paper, coated paper, circulars, envelopes, manila folders.
- Plastics: All household plastics (1 through 7) *except for plastic bags, motor oil jugs, and pesticide containers.*

## NOT ACCEPTED

- Paper plates & cups
- Styrofoam/Packaging
- Tissues, napkins, paper towels
- Food-contaminated containers (i.e pizza boxes)
- Foil-lined items like cookie and chip bags
- Grass clippings

***\*\*No Plastic bags in container***




