New Utility Rates Set


1. Pursuant to Kimberly Municipal Code §13.04.030A, the following monthly water/sewer charges shall be as follows:

Sewer:	\$37.36
Sanitation:	\$11.15
Water: Fixed Charge	\$18.09
Variable Charge	\$1.00/ 1,000 gallons
Bond: 2010 Bond	\$13.32
Temporary Bond Reduction (\$ 6.08)	

Temporary Bond Reduction is for 24 months, February 2013 through January 2015.

2. Each resident with a pressurized irrigation system shall be charged each month a fee for the maintenance and repair of the pressurized irrigation systems based on the following formula: One half of the resident's lot square footage multiplied by \$0.00168336.

3. These charges and fees shall be effective beginning February 1, 2013.

Per Ordinance #480, all dogs over the age of six months must be licensed and vaccinated. Bring in your current vaccination record to get your license at City Hall. Cost is \$5 before April 1st and \$10 after.
