8.12.010: OWNER RESPONSIBILITY:

- A. Every owner, tenant, occupant, or developer of private property within the city shall cut and remove the weeds, grass and rubbish upon and from such private property to the center of any street or alley along or in front of such property including the parking within and the curbing abutting such property and to cut and remove the same as often thereafter during each year and every year as may be necessary and essential to prevent their growth, seeding, and becoming a fire hazard.
- B. All private property will be maintained, mowed, or cut to keep the weed growth to no more than six inches (6") high. (Ord. 577, 2010: Ord. 561 § 1, 2008)
