## City of Kimberly Now Offers Online Bill Payment

As a way to offer you more choices in how you pay your bills, City of Kimberly now lets you pay your bills online. We have partnered with Xpress Bill Pay, the premier provider for online bill payment systems.

All you need is an Internet connection through a Web browser and an e-mail address. Once you sign up for your free account and start using this service, you'll wonder how you ever got along without it!

It's simple to use. Every month we'll send you a reminder e-mail to let you know when your bill is online. Then you just log in to your account at XpressBillPay.com and view your bill. It's formatted like your paper statement so it will look familiar to you.

You can also see up to a full year's history of your account online, so you can compare your current bill to a year ago.

When you're ready to pay your bill, select a payment type. You can pay with credit card, debit card, or electronic funds transfer. Then enter the information and you're done! It's that easy, and it only takes you a few minutes each month.

We offered this service at the request of our customers — You asked and we delivered! To sign up, just go to [www.cityofkimberly.org](http://www.cityofkimberly.org) and click on the Online Payment Button which will direct you to [www.xpressbillpay.com](http://www.xpressbillpay.com) and follow the instructions there. (You will need your account number to sign up and if you encounter problems xpressbillpay customer service is there to help you!)

## SIRCOMM C.A.N

The Disaster Service Directors for Gooding, Jerome, Lincoln, and Twin Falls County have received funding through grants to assist SIRCOMM in providing the citizens of Magic Valley an emergency alert system to be known as SIRCOMM Citizen Alert Notification system or SIRCOMM C.A.N.

Get notified about emergencies and other important community news by signing up for SIRCOMM C.A.N. This system enables us to provide you with critical information quickly in a variety of situations, such as fire and law enforcements emergencies, severe weather, hazardous material incidents, unexpected road closures, missing persons and evacuations of buildings or neighborhoods.

You will receive time-sensitive messages where you specify, such as your home, business or school through your home, cell or business phones, email address, text message and more. You pick where, you pick how.
