

Proclamation for National Police Week 2012

To recognize National Police Week 2012 and to honor the service and sacrifice of those law enforcement officers killed in the line of duty while protecting our communities and safeguarding our democracy.

WHEREAS, there are approximately 900,000 law enforcement officers serving in communities across the United States, including the dedicated members of the KIMBERLY POLICE DEPARTMENT;


WHEREAS, some 60,000 assaults against law enforcement officers are reported each year, resulting in approximately 16,000 injuries;


WHEREAS, since the first recorded death in 1791, over 20,000 law enforcement officers in the United States have made the ultimate sacrifice and been killed in the line of duty, including 66 Idaho law enforcement officers;

WHEREAS, the names of these dedicated public servants are engraved on the walls of the National Law Enforcement Officers Memorial in Washington, D.C.;

WHEREAS, May 15 is designated as Peace Officers Memorial Day, in honor of all fallen officers and their families;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that THE CITY OF KIMBERLY formally designates May 14 -20, 2012, as Police Week in KIMBERLY, ID, and publicly salutes the service of law enforcement officers in our community and in communities across the nation.
