Thank you for joining Kimberly in celebrating Good Neighbor Day!! This is your parade entry packet. In order to promote a safe, fun and enjoyable experience for the parade entrants and spectators, please carefully read the following information.

Parade Day: Saturday, July 14th, 2018

Parade Start Time: 10:30 A.M.

Parade Registration Opens: 9:00 A.M.

PARADE STAGING

- Parade registration will open at 9:00 a.m. Please DO NOT arrive earlier than 9:00 a.m. or later than 10:00 a.m.
- Parade registration is located at the west entrance to the K.H.S. parking lot on Emerald Drive.
- All entries must check in at the Registration area. Upon checking in you will receive your entry number to affix to your entry.
- Your parade number should be prominently displayed on the right hand side of your entry.
- Once you receive your entry number please place your entry in the position indicated on the parade application you submitted. All horse type entry will line-up on Oak Street near the football field and all other entries will line-up in the KHS parking lot. Please keep all entry's facing east and in the actual striped parking areas. ALL NON-PARADE VEHICLES NEED TO PARK AT THE MIDDLE SCHOOL AND STAY CLEAR OF THE STAGING AREA.
- Please familiarize yourself with the line-up position for your entry number and the over-all parade route. The parade will begin as close to 10:30 a.m. as possible.
- We will notify you when it is time to close ranks and begin the parade.

PARKING

Please try to minimize the number of cars coming to the Registration/Staging area; Meet your group elsewhere and come together to the Registration/Staging area. There is limited parking available and dropping off people increases the congestion if done one at a time.

ALL NON-PARADE VEHICLES NEED TO PARK AT THE MIDDLE SCHOOL AND STAY CLEAR OF THE STAGING AREA.

Please do not arrive prior to 9:00 A.M. The parade does not begin until 10:30 A.M.

PARADE RULES AND ETIQUETTE

- **Please keep about "Fifty Feet" between each entry while in the parade. Help us keep the parade moving and free of gaps.**
- We are one of the few parades that still allow participants to throw candy from a float or car. (Future ability to throw candy depends on you?) Safety is our number one priority and we appreciate your help.
- Make sure any candy thrown to spectators is done so in a safe manner so as not to harm anyone. Keep the candy far away from parade traffic so as not to entice children to run into the street.
- If you have a motorized entry, do not excessively rev your engine and do not spin your tires.
- Entries that will distribute candy (hand candy to spectators on the sidewalk) will be entered at end of the parade line-up. Candy and prizes may be distributed to the crowd by persons from your group or business walking along the sidewalk on the parade route and handing the items to the spectators.
- ENTRIES MUST FINISH THE PARADE..NO PEELING OFF PARADE ROUTE ONCE STARTED!
